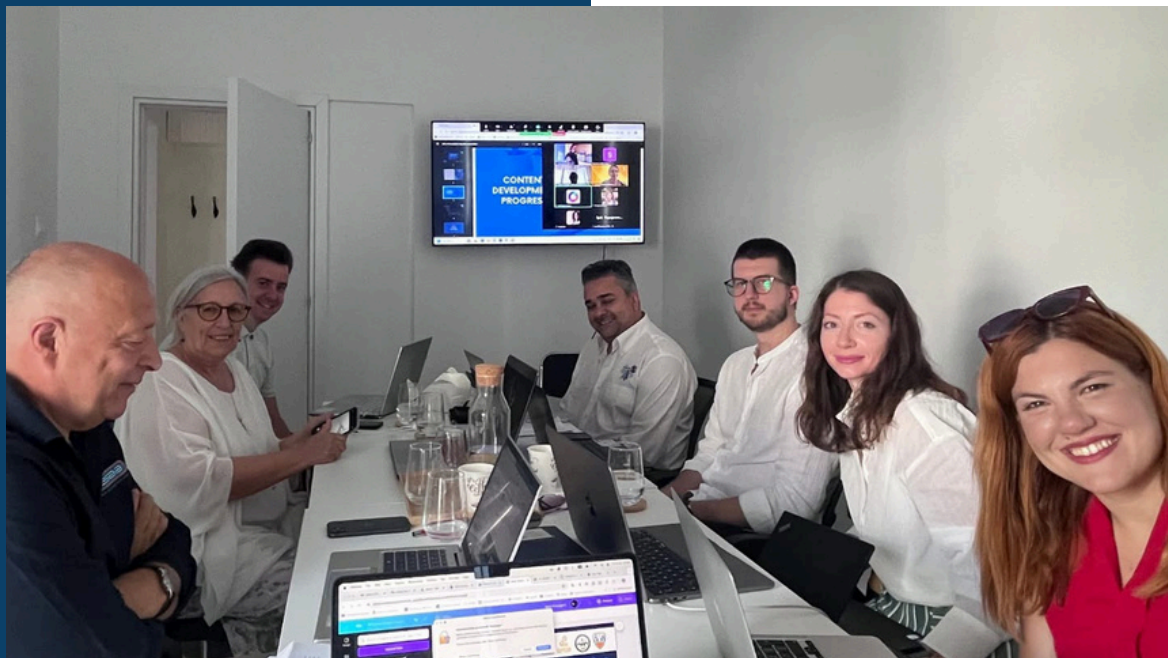

## • Needs report

We've successfully completed the research phase of our project, which included:

- Expert Interviews: Engaged with 60 experts from six countries, gathering insights from professionals in sports, education, psychology, and more.
- Student - Athlete Questionnaires: Collected valuable data from over 300 student-athletes in each country, gaining insights into their educational experiences, needs, and gaps.
- Desk Research: Analyzed existing educational programs to identify current offerings and areas for improvement.

## • Online meetings

All partners had the opportunity to meet each other online and present the structure of the MOOC and the guidelines of educational resources.

## • WP2-Development of educational resources

An educational program for acquiring transversal skills of young athletes aged 14 to 19 and 20 guidelines in the form of instructions for creating MOOC education according to modules from the educational program
